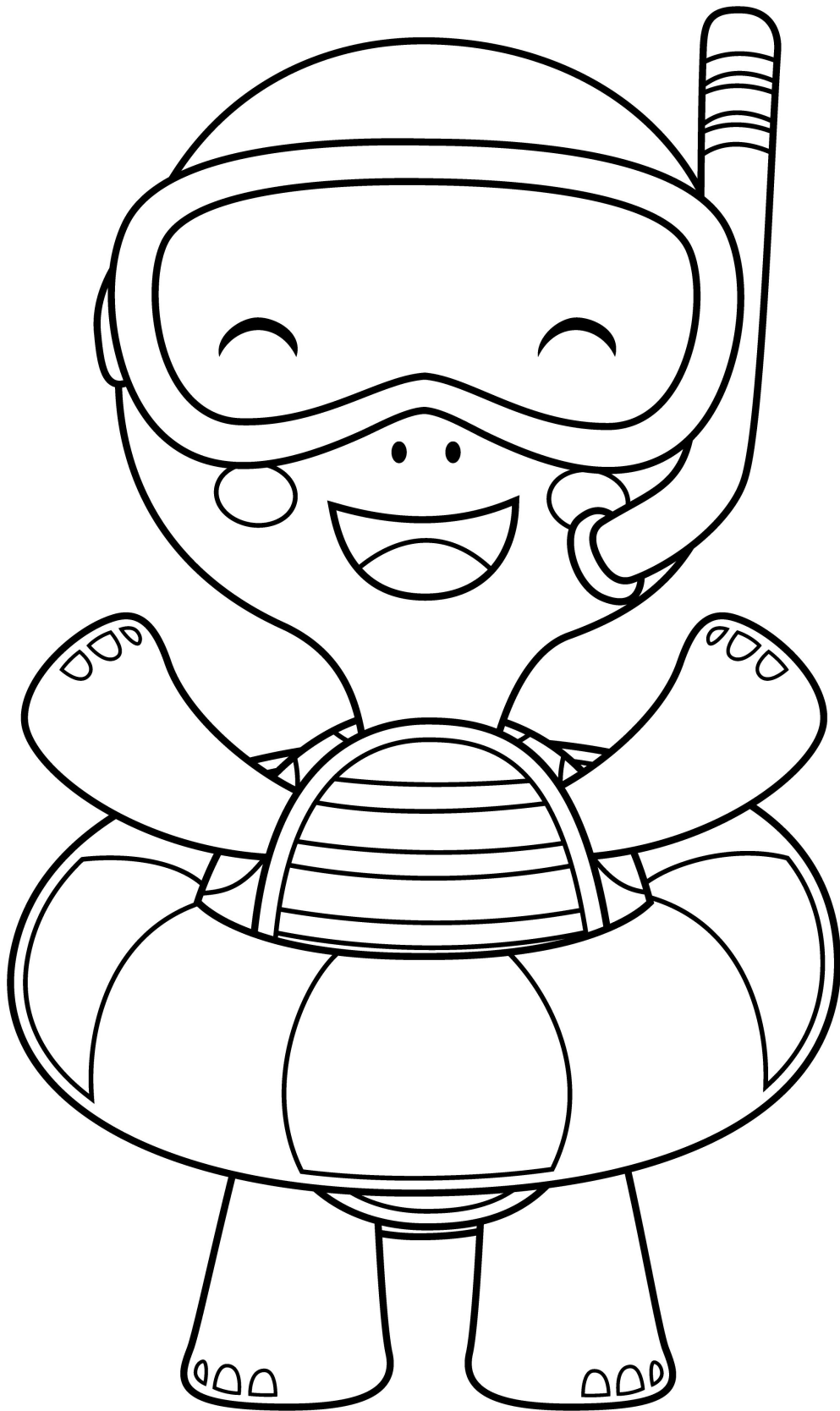


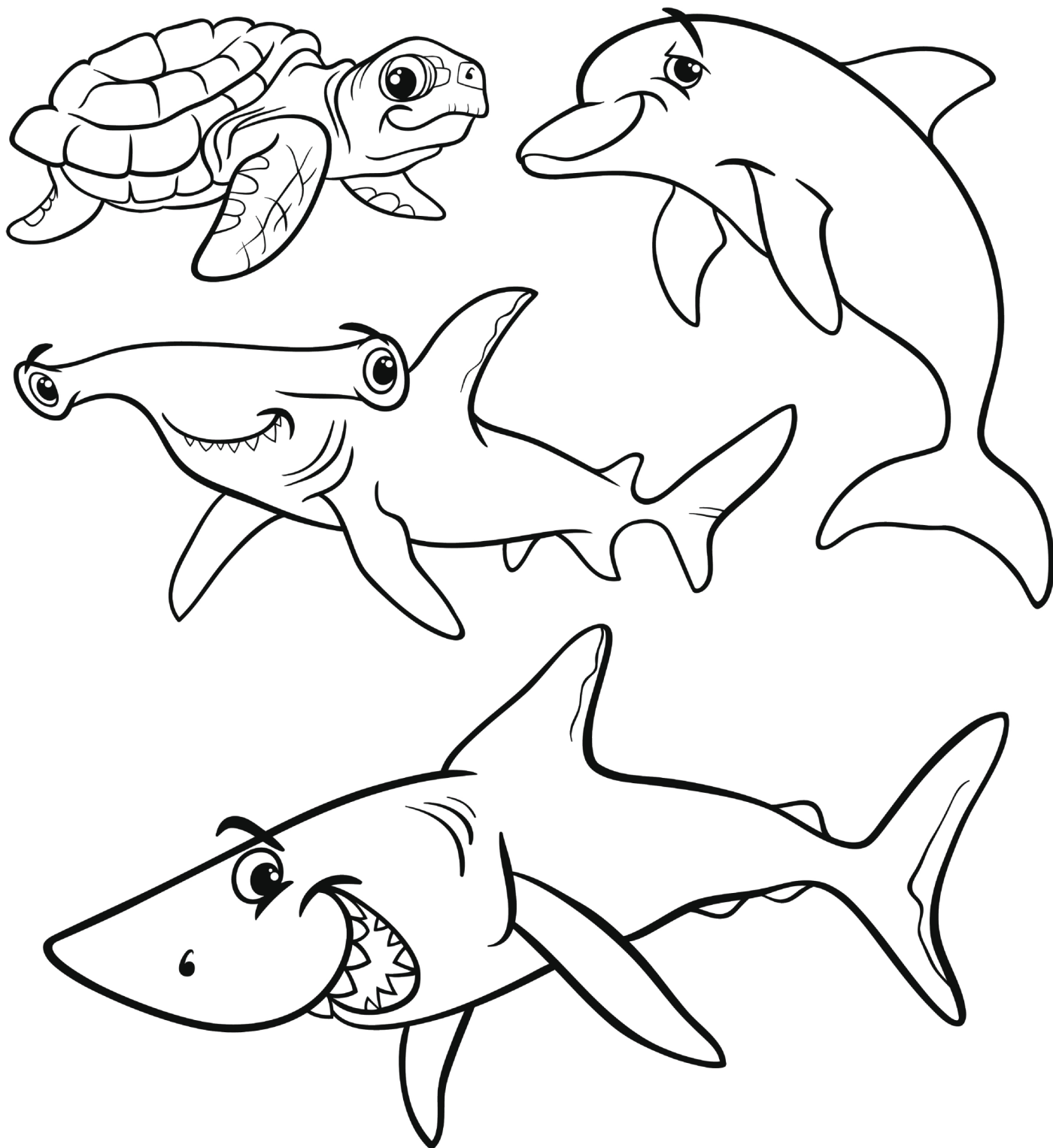


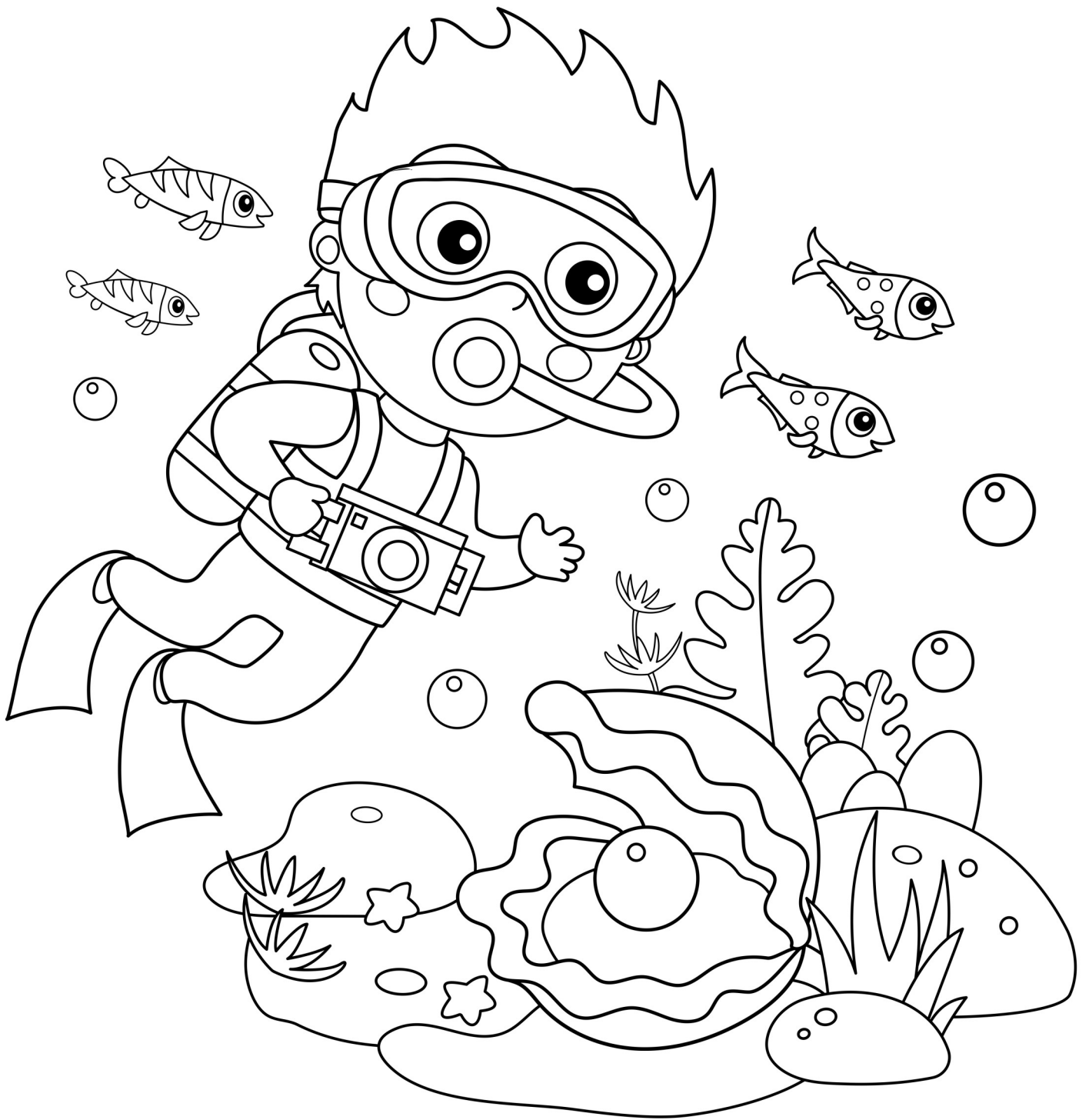

5 Little Seashells

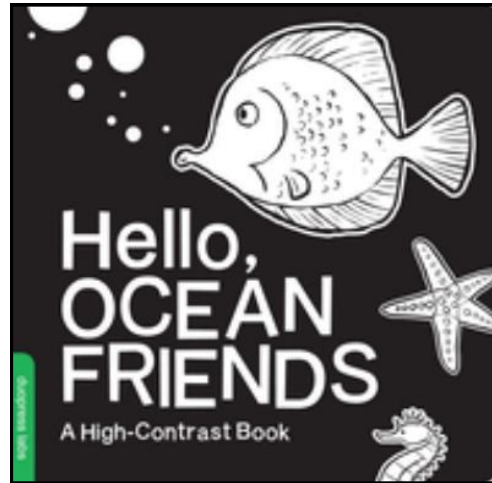
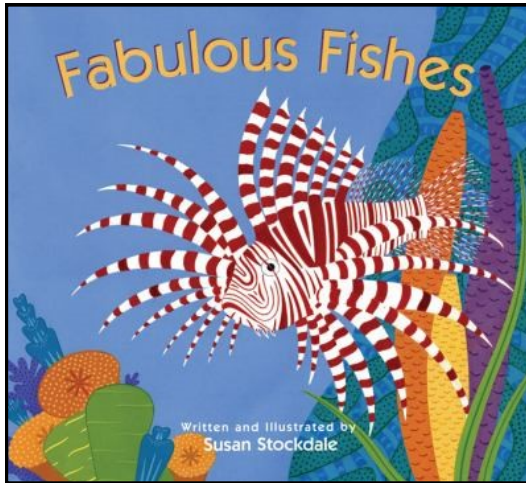
Five little seashells lying on the shore,

I whispered "Shhh" as I took it home.



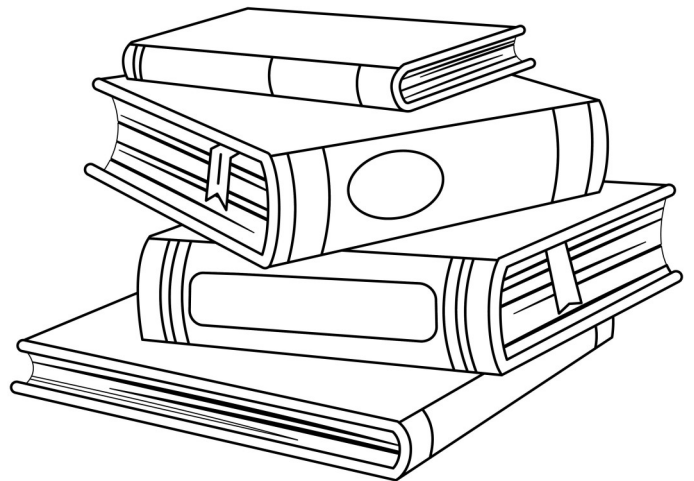

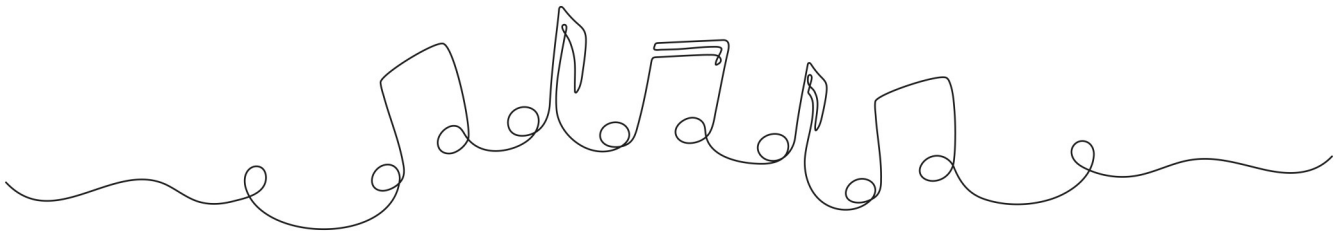
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Every Child Ready to Read Skill

Singing helps break language down into smaller sounds and helps children develop listening skills and hear the rhythms and rhymes of language. It also helps to provide a sense of security through familiar songs.

- Use songs to soothe and to play
- Use songs in routines like bedtime or feeding
