## **One little, Two Little**

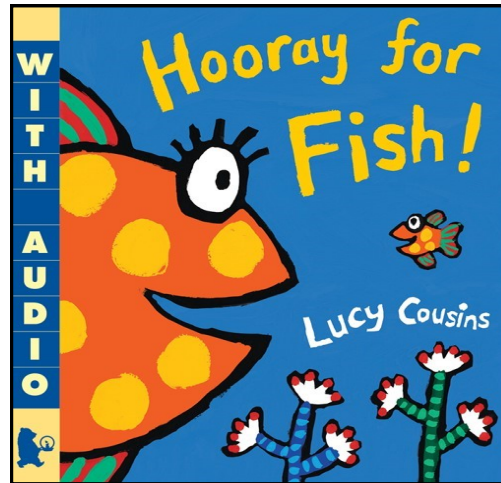
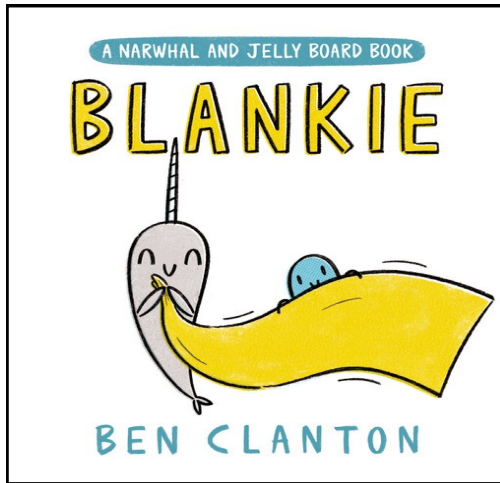
One little, Two little, Three little Blowfish

Ten little Blowfish puff their cheeks!



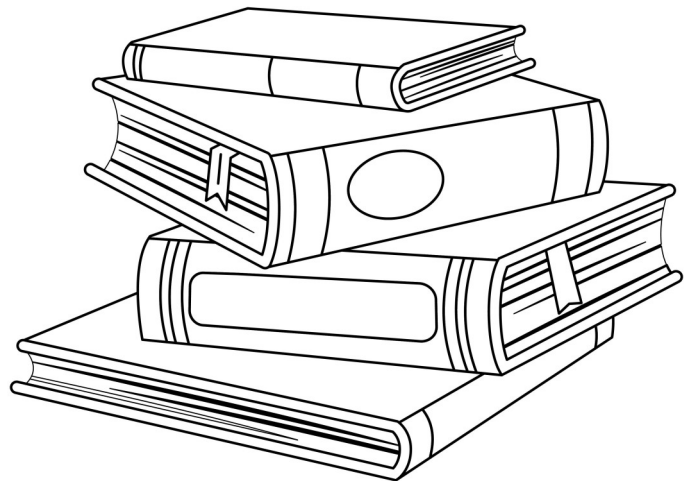

# Every Child Ready to Read Skill

## Reading

Sharing stories, talking, and singing every day helps your child's development in many ways.

You're getting your child familiar with sounds, words, language, print, and eventually, the value and joy of books. This builds your child's early literacy skills, including the ability to focus, and helps your child go on to read successfully later in childhood.



## Resource Shoutout



Head Start is an income-based early child development and preschool program with full-day pre-k classes. Head Start increases the school readiness of children ages 3 to 4 years old.

Head Start encourages families to apply January through May prior to the start of the school year but accepts applications throughout the year.
