'Cause I'm a bat,

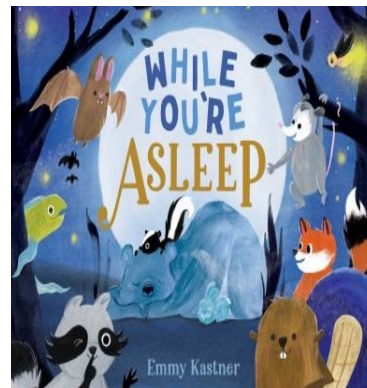
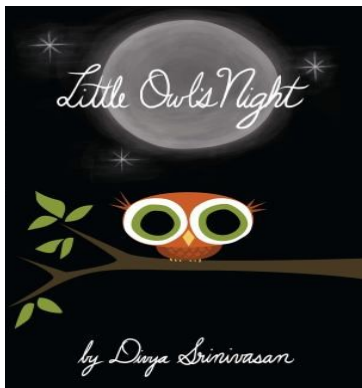

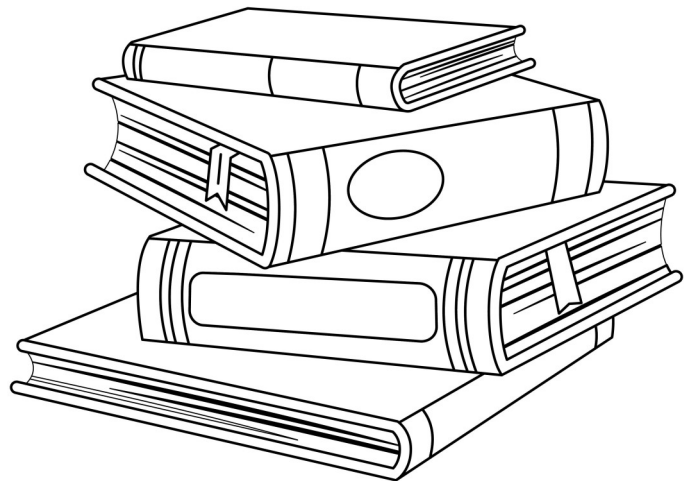

Playing

Play is the work that children do to naturally understand and learn about the world in which they live.

- Toddlers – build with blocks, do puzzles, or play dress up! (gross motor skills)
- Preschoolers – participate in a team sport, play board games, play kitchen/house/restaurant/ construction worker, etc.! (dramatic play)

The type of play that is most important is free play.

It is led by the child's interest and progresses as far as the child's ability and imagination will allow.
