COMMITTEE REPORTS

### Finance & Planning Committee

Staff reported on the status of the Brandon Library replacement. A purchase contract for two parcels of land is under a due diligence review period that expires in August. An alternative proposal for a town center project is in preliminary discussions. Staff recently met with the Center Place executive board to address questions regarding the current Brandon Library building.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The dedication ceremony for the new C. Blythe Andrews, Jr. Library is set for Sunday, May 26, 2019 starting at 2 pm.

The Library has been awarded a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts for The Big Read, featuring *The Things They Carried* by Tim O'Brien. A kick-off event will be planned for April 2020. The Library is partnering with Hillsborough County Public Schools, Florida Museum of Photographic Arts and Hillsborough Community College – Ybor Campus to have related events.

An update was provided on Library Board vacancies and reappointments, which are scheduled on the June 6, 2019 BOCC Consent Agenda. Outgoing Library Board member, Shelley Blood, was presented with a letter and certificate from the Board of County Commissioners in appreciation for her service on the Public Library Board.

The June Library Board meeting has been canceled due to budget preparations and summer programs.

Staff presented a recap of 2019 Libcon and Afrocon community events.

The Library is honored to have been named Florida Library of the Year 2019 by the Florida Library Association.

Staff provided an update on the Summer Reading program.
